| Uniform Requirements | Goalkeepers must wear protective equipment and a different coloured shirt from that of both teams. |
| | Track pants may not be worn as a playing uniform. |
| | Each P1 player must wear a shirt with a number on the back at least 30cm |
| | in height. Each P1 goalkeeper must have their number on their back. |
| | No outfield player may take the field unless they are wearing shin pads and a mouth guard. |
| | No player may wear a peaked cap, although collapsible sun visors may be |
| | worn. |

| Equipment | Each team must supply one match ball for each game. Teams will agree which ball will be used before the game, with the spares being used in case of the match ball leaves the fenced area. A coloured ball may be used as an alternative if playing under lights makes a white ball difficult to see. |
